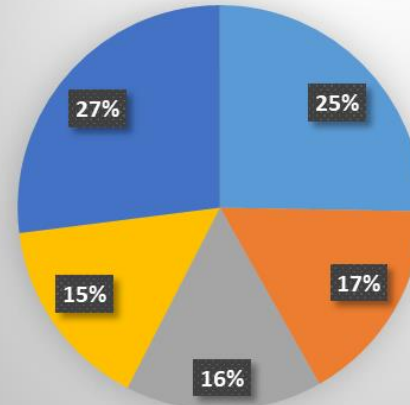

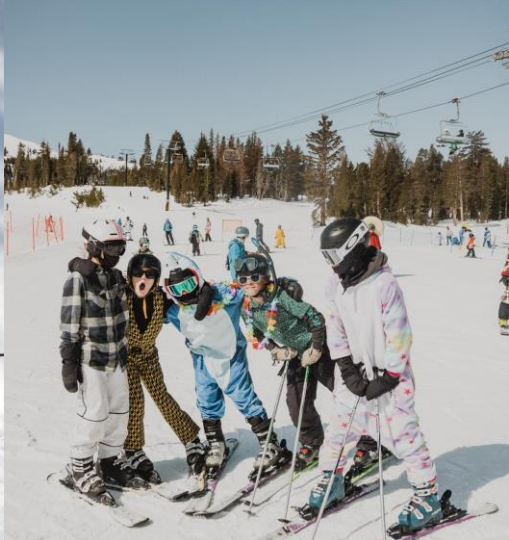

Total Funds Raised: \$1,361,879

In Kind Donations: \$341,344

After two difficult years through COVID, our fundraising efforts for 2021-22 proved stronger than ever. In 2020 & 2021, all but 1 special event had been cancelled. In 2022, MMCF reinstated all three of our special events, which returned as the cornerstone of our fundraising, providing more than 42% of our income. 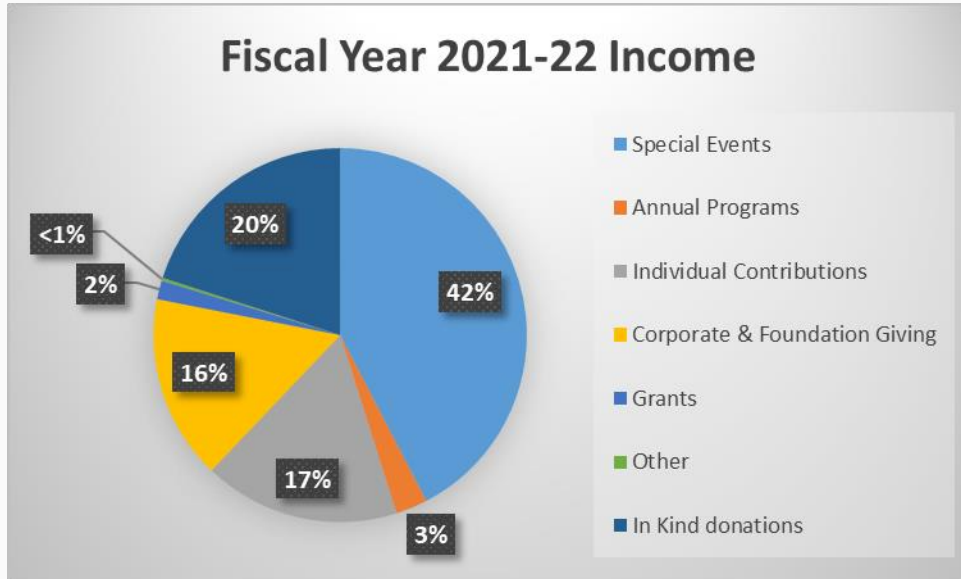
